**C Y CHILDREN'S YOUNG PEOPLE'S ACTIVITIES**

**B BAZAAR**  
The bazaar at Beeston Festival is bursting with over a hundred stalls offering food from around the world (next to the bowling greens) plus local produce, clothing, jewellery, crafts, plants, tombolas and games. 
**R RUGBY**
